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A mon Frère le paysan-Fransiz canra 1999-12-31 Élisée Reclus, de son nom complet Jacques Élisée Reclus, est un géographe, militant et penseur de l'anarchisme français. Il fut un écrivain prolifique, aussi bien dans son domaine professionnel de la géographie terrestre, que sur les thèmes de la vie humaine et de l'anarchisme. Le bannissement politique d'Élisée Reclus pour ses idées anarchistes a certainement été à l'origine de l'oubli relatif dans lequel il est aujourd'hui.
