With forays into archaeology, neuroscience, biology, and design, Cox explains how sound is made and altered by the environment, how our body reacts to peculiar noises, and how these mysterious wonders illuminate sound's surprising dynamics in everyday settings—from your bedroom to the opera house. *The Sound Book* encourages us to become better listeners in a world dominated by the visual and to open our ears to the glorious cacophony all around us.
