Technics and Time: The fault of Epimetheus-Bernard Stiegler 1998 What is a technical object? At the beginning of Western philosophy, Aristotle contrasted beings formed by nature, which had within themselves a beginning of movement and rest, and man-made objects, which did not have the source of their own production within themselves. This book, the first of three volumes, revises the Aristotelian argument and develops an innovative assessment whereby the technical

object can be seen as having an essential, distinct temporality and dynamics of its own. The Aristotelian concept persisted, in one form or another, until Marx, who conceived of the possibility of an evolution of technics. Lodged between mechanics and biology, a technical entity became a complex of heterogeneous forces. In a parallel development, while industrialization was in the process of overthrowing the contemporary order of knowledge as well as contemporary social organization, technology was acquiring a new place in philosophical questioning. Philosophy was for the first time faced with a world in which technical expansion was so widespread that science was becoming more and more subject to the field of instrumentality, with its ends determined by the imperatives of economic struggle or war, and with its epistemic status changing accordingly. The power that emerged from this new relation was unleashed in the course of the two world wars. Working his way through the history of the Aristotelian assessment of technics, the author engages the

ideas of a wide range of thinkers--Rousseau, Husserl, and Heidegger, the paleo-ontologist Leroi-Gourhan, the anthropologists Vernant and Detienne, the sociologists Weber and Habermas, and the systems analysts Maturana and Varela. The Age of Disruption-Bernard Stiegler
2019-09-10 Half a century ago Adorno and Horkheimer argued, with great prescience, that our increasingly rationalized world was witnessing the emergence of a new kind of barbarism, thanks in part to the stultifying effects of the culture industries. What they could not foresee was that, with the digital revolution and the pervasive automation associated with it, the developments they had discerned would be greatly accentuated, giving rise to the loss of reason and to the loss of the reason for living. Individuals are now overwhelmed by the sheer quantity of digital information and the speed of digital flows, resulting in a kind of technological Wild West in which they find themselves increasingly powerless, driven by their lack of agency to the point of madness. How can we find a way out of this situation? In this major new

book, Bernard Stiegler argues that we must first acknowledge our era as one of fundamental disruption and detachment. We are living in an absence of epokhē in the philosophical sense, by which Stiegler means that we have lost our path of thinking and being. Weaving in powerful accounts from his own life story, including struggles with depression and time spent in prison, Stiegler calls for a new epokhē based on public power. We must forge new circuits of meaning outside of the established algorithmic routes. For only then will forms of thinking and life be able to arise that restore meaning and aspiration to the individual. Concluding with a dialogue between Stiegler and Jean-Luc Nancy, this book will be of great interest to students and scholars in social and cultural theory, media and cultural studies, philosophy and the humanities generally.

La Diversité québécoise en débat-Bernard Gagnon (collectif) 2013-02-05T11:47:02-05:00 Le projet de ce livre est né après la publication du rapport de la Commission Bouchard-Taylor, en mai 2008, avec pour objectif de recueillir les réactions d'universitaires sur le contenu du

rapport et, plus largement, sur l'état de la diversité au Québec. Le symposium Penser la diversité québécoise, organisé à l'automne 2008 à l'UQAM, a réuni les différents collaborateurs de cet ouvrage et a servi de point de départ aux discussions et délibérations des auteurs. Le débat sur la diversité au Québec est loin d'être clos, comme le démontrent l'actualité politique ainsi que les idées et opinions exprimées dans les médias - pluralisme, laïcité, accommodements raisonnables, diversité... Ce livre apporte une contribution originale en ce sens qu'il cherche, au-delà de l'enjeu des accommodements culturels, à replacer le débat sur le pluralisme culturel et religieux dans le contexte du devenir de la nation québécoise. La diversité est devenue un incontournable dans la définition du vivre-ensemble au Québec. En réponse à la « crise » des accommodements raisonnables, la Commission Bouchard-Taylor devait clarifier les rapports entretenus par la société québécoise avec le pluralisme culturel et religieux, et recommander des ajustements souhaitables.
